

## Prindle to N.W. Electric Co.

In consideration of thirty five dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Robt C. Prindle and Louisa A. Prindle husband and wife grant to Northwestern Electric company a perpetual right of way across the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit: Lot one in Section 12 and the south half of the south half of section 1 all in Township one north of range five East of Willamette Meridian for the purpose of erecting maintaining and operating two pole or tower lines for the transmission of electric current, with the right to cut such trees and brush as may be necessary in constructing maintaining and protecting such lines from damage. The lines of poles shall be upon the charger line from a point near the west line of said land on the surveyed line to a point in the surveyed line near the easterly line of said land and to run north of the residence of grantors and as nearly in a straight line as practicable but not nearer than 100 feet to said residence; said lines of poles to be erected not to exceed 50 feet apart. these rights are subject to a lease of right of way to Washington Northern Railroad Co. in which is railroad is constructed.

In consideration of one dollar the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged O.C. Train and Elena Train his wife grant to Northwestern Electric Company a perpetual right of way in and over the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington: The Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of section 36 in Township 3 North of range 7 1/2 East of Willamette Meridian; also the southwest quarter of said northeast quarter of sec. 36 in said township and range., for the purpose of erecting maintaining and operating thereon two pole or tower lines for the transmission of electric current, together with the right to cut such trees and brush as may be necessary in the constructing maintaining and protecting such lines from damage. One of said pole or tower lines is to be constructed on the line now surveyed and staked over and across said land and the other is to be erected northerly and not exceeding 50 feet distant therefrom.
