

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT Kurt Clausen & Philip Dean Boyer  
acting as agents for Utah International, Inc. the  
 undersigned citizens of the United States, have, this 6 day  
 of November 1980, located and claimed, and do hereby locate  
 and claim by right of discovery and location, in compliance with  
 the Mining Act of Congress, approved May 10, 1872, and all  
 subsequent Acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations,  
 the Rocky # 137 (Quartz Lode) Mining Claim.

Said claim is located in the McLau Creek Mining District,  
 County of Skamania, and State of Washington.

Said claim is described by metes and bounds as follows, to  
 wit: Beginning at the NE corner (Cor. No. 1), then running  
 thence 1500 feet W, to the NW corner (Cor. No. 2);  
 thence 600 feet S, to the SW corner (Cor. No. 3);  
 thence 1500 feet E, to the SE corner (Cor. No. 4);  
 thence 600 feet N, to the NE corner (Cor. No. 1),  
 the place beginning.

Said claim runs 1475 feet in a W direction, and  
25 feet in a E direction each way from the discovery  
 point, and 300 feet on each side of the discovery point, the  
 same being 600 feet wide by 1500 feet in length. The point  
 of discovery upon which this notice is posted is 25 feet in  
 a W direction from the center of the E end line.

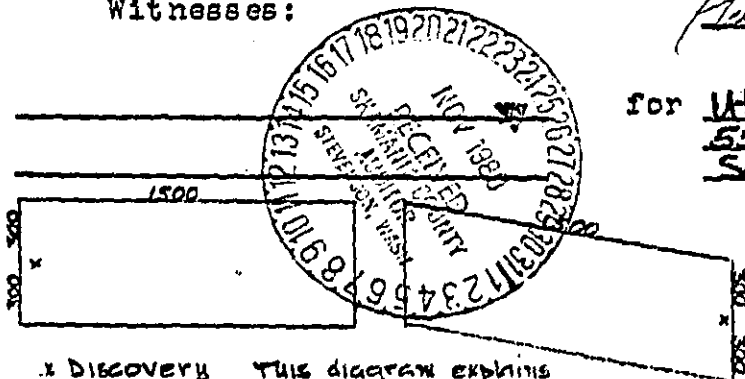
Said claim is further described as being located in the
