

thence in a northerly direction with an angle of eighty five degrees twenty one minutes, two hundred sixty eight feet; thence in an easterly direction with an angle of ninety four degrees thirty nine minutes one hundred sixty two and 5/10 feet, thence in a southerly direction with an angle of eighty five degrees twenty one minutes two hundred sixty eight feet to place of beginning containing 1 acre more or less. To have and to hold the said premises with their appurtenances unto the said party of the second part its successors and assigns forever. And the said party of the first part for himself and for his heirs executors and administrators does hereby covenant to and with the said party of the second part its successors and assigns that he is lawfully seized in fee simple of above granted premises, and that they are free from all incumbrances and that he will warrant and defend the same against all lawful claims whatsoever.

U.S. to Santa Fe P. Rd. Co.

The United States of America, to all to whom these presents shall come greeting:

Selection No. 14188

Whereas the Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company being the owner of a tract of land situated in and included within the limits of a public forest reservation and officially designated as the San Francisco Mountains Forest Reserve in Arizona, has under the provisions of the Act approved June 4th 1897 entitled an Act making appropriations for the sundry civil expenses of the Government for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth 1898 and for other purposes, reconveyed and relinquished the said tract of land to the United States and has, under the provisions of said Act, selected in lieu thereof the following described tract of vacant public land now open for settlement to-wit:

The Lot three of section seven in Township three North of Range eight East of the Willamette Meridian, containing thirty eight and twenty hundredths acres.

Now know Ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises, Has given and granted and by these presents does give and grant unto the said Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company and to its successors and assigns the lands above described. To have and to hold the same together with the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company and to its successors and assigns forever.

And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by authority of the United States.
