The United States of America, To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:

Vancouver 0820

Whereas the Astec Land and Cattle Company Limited, being the owner of a tract of land situated and included within the limits of a public forest reservation, known and officialt designated as the San Francisco Mountain Forest Reserve, Arizona, has, under the provisions of the Act approved June 4th 1897 entitled an Act making appropriations for the civil sundry expenses of the Government and for other purposes, reconveyed and relinquished the said tract to the United States and has, under the provisions of said act selected in lieu thereof the following described tract of Public vacant land now open for settlement, to-wit:

The Lots two and seven of Section fifteen and the Lot six of section fourteen in Township two North of Range seven East of Willamette Meridian, Washington, containing thirty three and eighty four hundredth acres. Now Know Ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises has given and granted and by these presents does give and grant unto the said Astec Land and Cattle Co. limited and to its successors and assigns the lands above described; to have and to hold the same together with the appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto be, longing unto the said Astec Land and Cattle Company Limited and to its successors and assigns forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining agriculture manufacturing or other purposes and rights of ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized by the local laws customs and regulations and decisions of Courts? And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.
