Notice of Location of Mining Claim

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned Kurt Youenes and Lawrence S. Tetas, acting as agents for Utah International, Inc.

having complied with the requirements of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and with all the local laws, customs and regulations, have this 15th day of May, 1979, located a claim and by these presents do locate a claim by right of discovery and location, 1500 linear feet horizontal measurement on and along lode, vein, ledge or deposit, along the vein thereof, with all dips, angles and variations as allowed by law, together with 300 feet on the N side and 300 feet on the S side of the middle of said vein at the surface so far as can be determined from present developments, and all veins, lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground within the lines of said claim, 1450 linear feet, running W from this discovery post and 50 feet running E from this discovery post, said discovery post being situated upon said lode, vein or deposit and within the lines of said claim in McCoy Creek mining district, Skamania County, State of Washington, which claim is more particularly described as follows:

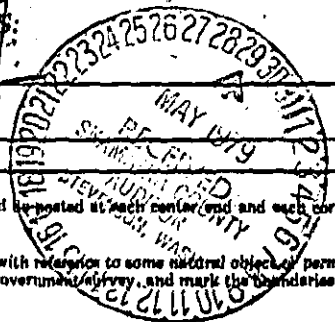
Commencing at this discovery post being the center of the vein, and upon which this notice is posted thence 50 feet E to a post marked E center end; thence 300 feet S to a post marked SE corner; thence 1500 feet W to a post marked SW corner; thence 600 feet N to a post marked center end; thence feet to a post marked NW corner; thence 1500 feet E to a post marked NE corner; thence 300 feet S to E center end.

Said claim is located in SECTION 15 T.10N, R.8E and the SE corner of said claim is ~7600' S.33 W of Juniper Peak and is designated and known as Rocky #15

Witnesses are not necessary, but advisable. Fill out all blanks with ink or indelible pencil.

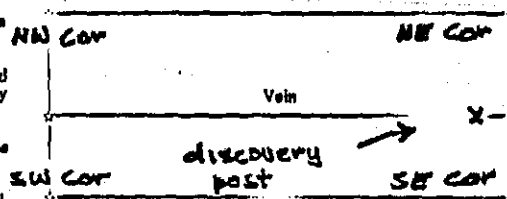


Diagram explaining mode of staking claim.
