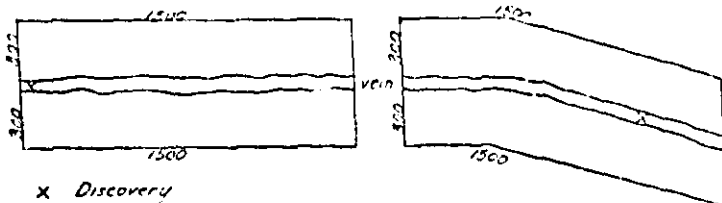


Notice of Mining Location

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter six of Title thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the laws of the above State, and the local customs and regulations of said District, have located and do

hereby locate a claim 1500 linear feet in length, and 600 feet in width on the

Firlock II (lode of quartz in place) lode, vein, ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in the above State, County and Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel),

from thence 600 feet in a N 10°W direction to an end post marked

No. 2, thence 300 feet in a S 80°W direction to a corner post marked

600 feet in a S 10°E direction and

No. 3, thence 900 feet in a S 30°E direction to a corner post marked

No. 4, thence 600 feet in a N 80°E direction to a corner post marked

900 feet in a N 30°W direction and

No. 5, thence 600 feet in a N 10°W direction to a corner post marked

No. 6, thence 300 feet in a S 80°W direction to said end post No. 2;

hereby locating and intending to claim 600 feet in a N 10°W (upstream

Boulder creek) direction from discovery to the North end line.

and 900 feet in a S 30°E (downstream Boulder creek) direction from discovery to the South

end line and 300 feet on each side of the middle of said lode or ledge, for the purpose of mining the same and claiming all surface rights, privileges, and minerals, with all dips, spurs, angles and variations, and other rights granted by existing laws and customs.

This claim is further described as follows: On National Forest land (Gifford Pinchot National Forest). In Boulder Creek, tributary of the Lewis River. South end line is below the Boulder Creek falls approximately 3/4 (three fourths) mile upstream from Forest Service road N 90. Corner number 4 is 300 feet West of Boulder creek and corner number 5 is 300 feet East of Boulder creek. Claim runs 1500 feet upstream with Boulder creek the approximate centerline and 300 feet of the North end line coincides with the South side line of Firlock I claim which was located July 28, 1978 and recorded September 6, 1978. The land is unsurveyed but land description projections on National Forest maps indicate Section 23, Township 9 North, Range 9 East, W.M. Inconsistency in maps preclude estimating a smaller area however it appears consistently in the extreme South of Section 23, and/or the

This notice is placed at Discovery on post No. 1; posts are placed at each corner, and the name of this lode, and date of location, are placed on all posts.
