As a part consideration evidenced by the delivery and acceptance of this deed it is mutually agreed between the parties hereto as follows: that no vinous, malt, fermented or distilled liquor, or intoxicating drinks of any kind shall ever be manufactured or sold or offered for sale upon the said land by any person or persons, with or without license for the sale of liquor under the laws of the State of Washington.

Ramsey to Northwestern Electric Company.

In consideration of One Dollar, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Ellen Van Wessen-hove formerly Ellen Ramsey, widow of Edward Ramsey, deceased, does grant to Northwestern Electric Company a perpetual right-of-way in and over the following described real property, situated in County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

The southeast quarter of Section twenty-one (21) in township three (3) north, range ten (10) east of the Willamette Meridian; excepting that part of said land on which J.W. Marsh had a bond for a deed. for the purpose of erecting, maintaining and operating thereon one pole or tower lines for the transmission of electric current; together with the right to cut such trees and brush as may be necessary in constructing, maintaining and protecting such lines from damage. The line is surveyed and enters the land 300 feet south of the 16th corner on the west line of the tract, and runs thence in a straight line to the northeast corner of the tract.
