

Hamilton to N.W. Electric Co.

In consideration of one dollar the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Myrtle Attwell grant to Northwestern Electric Company a perpetual right of way in and over the following described property situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

The S.M. Hamilton Donation Land claim situated in sections nineteen and twenty Township two North of Range seven East of W.M., for the purpose of erecting mainline and operating two pole or tower lines for the transmission of electric current, together with the right to cut such trees and brush as may be necessary for the constructing mainline and protecting such lines from damage. When constructed the poles or towers shall be at least 40 feet in height and no power or cables shall be nearer to the ground than twenty six feet. One line is surveyed and staked across the land and enters the easterly line about 800 feet southerly from the northeast corner of the claim and runs in a straight line to a point in the westerly line of the claim which is 1966 feet northerly from the intersection of said westerly line with the south line of said section nineteen. The second line shall be constructed parallel to and not to exceed fifty feet north of the surveyed line. The merchantable timber which is necessary to cut shall be paid for at the rate of \$2.00 per thousand feet board measure, payment to be made within two months from the time the trees are cut.

The S.M.
