

claimant as aforesaid is five thousand five hundred dollars, together with costs taxed at 188 dollars.

And the parties hereto by their respective attorneys having stipulated that the said sum of five thousand five hundred dollars may be paid by the said petitioner to the said claimant by the petitioner making an application of one-half of said sum, to wit; two thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$2750.) upon the mortgage debt of thirty-four hundred dollars (\$3400.), with interest, due and owing from said Thompson to said petitioner, the said mortgage debt being secured by a mortgage from said Thompson to A.Y. Marsh, dated the 22nd day of June, 1911, and recorded in Book "K" of Mortgages, page 220, of the Records of Skamania County, and assigned to the petitioner by an assignment dated the 29th day of March, 1912, and recorded in Book "K" of Mortgages, page 526 of the Records of Skamania County; and that the balance of said sum of \$5500., to wit, \$2750., may be paid to the attorneys of said Thompson instead of the Clerk of the above entitled court, and the court having made an order on the 28th day of September, 1912, that payment shall be made in accordance with the terms of said stipulation;

And it appearing to the court that such payment has been made and that the petitioner has been made and that the petitioner has paid the costs of these proceedings to the clerk of the above entitled court;

IT IS NOW CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND DECREED that the petitioner appropriate the following described property, to wit:

A strip of land of varying width across the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section Three, township Three North Range Ten East of Willamette Meridian, bounded on the northwesterly side by a line one hundred feet from ordinary high water in the White Salmon River, and on the southeasterly side by the center line of the said White Salmon river, containing four and nine hundredths (4.09) acres, more or less.

And also a tract described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of the west half of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section Three, Township Three North Range Ten East Willamette Meridian; thence West along the South line of said West half ninety feet more or less to a point one hundred feet from ordinary high water in White Salmon river; thence in a northerly direction one hundred feet from and parallel to the said ordinary high water line seven hundred feet more or less, to a point on the east line of said west one-half of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section three; thence south along said east line of west one-half to the line between Lots 305 $\frac{1}{2}$  and 306 Fruit Home Colony, produced westerly; thence easterly along said dividing line between Lots 305 $\frac{1}{2}$  and 306, Fruit Home Colony, to the center of White Salmon river; thence following along the center of the White Salmon river to the south line of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section Three; thence along the south line of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section Three to the point of beginning, containing one and aninety hundredths (1.90) acres, more or less.

And also a tract described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of the north half of the Northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section Three Township Three North Range Ten East Willamette Meridian, South sixty-two degrees twenty-three minutes West, fourteen hundred fifty-two and seven-tenths (1452.7) feet from the quarter-corner between Sections Two and Three, said township and range; thence North sixty-one degrees fifty-five minutes east three hundred eighty-five feet; thence North fifteen degrees no minutes east one hundred and twelve (112) feet; thence north twenty-five degrees fifty-six minutes west four hundred eighty-two and six-tenths (482.6) feet; thence north seventeen degrees fifteen minutes west four hundred and sixty (460) feet; thence North sixty-six degrees thirty minutes east forty-
