THIS INDENTURE, Made this 26th day of March A.D. 1919. by and between Edward T. Bracken and Emma K. Bracken, his wife, parties of the first part, and J. W. Page and Alice L. Page parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That whereas the parties of the second part has loaned to the parties of the first part the full sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred (\$1,700.00) Dollars, which sum the said parties of the first part agree to repay in Fifteen (15) yearly installments after this date, and to pay interest thereon annually at the rate of 7% per cent. per annum from this date until paid; and also to pay all taxes and assessments which may be assessed or levied to or against the parties of the second part, or assigns, on account of such loan.
