U.S. to Fries

U.S. Act of July 1 1898

Vancouver 0800

The United States of America To all to whom these presents may come Greeting:

Whereas there has been deposited on the General Land office of the United States a certificate of the register of the Land office at Vancouver Washington, whereas it appears that in accordance with the provisions of the act of Congress approved July 1st 1898 entitled an act making appropriations for the sundry civil expenses of the government for the fiscal year ending June 30th 1899 and for other purposes, Olaf Fries has entered the Lot three of section five in Township two North of Range seven east and the Lot two of section thirty two in Township seven north of Range six East of the Willamette Meridian, Washington containing forty nine and fifty hundredths acres. Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises has given and granted and by these presents does give and grant unto the said Olaf Fries and to his heirs the lands above described; to have and to hold the same together with the appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Olaf Fries and to his heirs and assigns forever; Subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining agriculture manufacturing or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs uses in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs laws and decisions of the Courts, and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by authority of the United States.

In Testimony Whereof I, William H. Taft, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land office to be hereunto affixed. Give under my hand at the city of Washington the sixth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and ten and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and thirty fifth
