WIND RIVER LBR. CO. TO NORTHWESTERN ELECTRIC CO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Wind River Lumber Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar to it paid by the Northwestern Electric Company, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant to said Northwestern Electric Company perpetual right-of-way in, over and across the following described lands, situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

A strip of land sixty (60) feet in width, beginning at a point in the West line of the Joseph Robins Donation Land Claim, in Section 27, T.3.N., R.8 E., W.M., which point is sixty (60) feet from, measured right angles to, the Northerly right-of-way line of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway; thence Southeasterly sixty (60) feet from and parallel to the Northerly line of said Railway right-of-way to a point in the South line of said Section 27 to the right-of-way line; thence Northwesterly along the right-of-way line to the West line of said Robins Donation Land Claim; thence North to place of beginning.

Also that part of the William M.Murphy Donation Land Claim North of the right-of-way of the Spokane. Portland & Seattle Railway, which was conveyed to said Wind River Lumber Company by George Miller and Virginia Miller, and being along the West side of said Donation Land Claim and adjoining Wind River.
