

## Galligan to N.W. Electric Co.

In consideration of One dollar the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Wilbur H Galligan and Margaret L. Galligan his wife grant to Northwestern Electric Co. a perpetual right of way in and over the following described real property situated in the county of Skamania state of Washington to-wit: Lots 1 and 2 and the northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 30 township three north of Range 10 east of willamette Meridian. For the purpose of erecting maining and operating two pole or tower lines for the transmission of electric current together with the right to cut such trees and brush as may be necessary for the maining maintaining and protecting such lines from damage. The first or south transmission line is surveyed and staked out across said land and the third last and middle survey is to be adopted by the Northwestern Electric company as said stakes are now located on the ground and said stakes are located entirely north of grantors land now cleared and in cultivation. The second transmission line shall be constructed parallel with the first line and not to exceed fifty feet from it in a northerly direction. Grantors reserve to themselves their heirs and assigns the entire use of the land included within said right of way for all purposes which do not interfere with the use of the same by grantees in occupying the same for the purposes herein mentioned and enjoying the right and easement herein granted. This agreement and grant is made by grantors and accepted by grantees as a substitute for that one executed by these grantors to grantees under date of May 22nd 1912
