KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Maggie Hanlon and B. F. Hanlon, the duly appointed, qualified and acting executrix and executor of the estate of Cornelius O. Hanlon, deceased, late of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, do hereby certify and declare that a certain mortgage bearing date the 7th day of March, A.D. 1910, made and executed by James Haffey, not married, mortgagor, to Walter Duggan, mortgagee, and recorded in the office of the County Auditor of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, in Book "I", record of Mortgages, on Page 191, on the 8th day of March, 1910, and thereafter, to-wit, on March 13, 1911, by said Walter Duggan duly assigned to C. O. Hanlon, which said mortgage was given to secure the payment of a certain promissory note dated March 7, 1910, for the sum of \$300.00 and made and executed by said James Haffey in favor of said Walter Duggan on and upon all the following described tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Homestead set apart for Catherine Haffey, widow of William Haffey, deceased, and her minor child Cornelius Haffey, out of the estate of said William Haffey, deceased, thence West along the said line of said estate to the Southeast corner of that tract or portion set apart for Frank E. Haffey out of the estate of said William Haffey; thence North to the North line of said estate, being the Northeast corner of that portion of land set apart for said Frank Haffey out of said estate; thence East along the North line of said estate to the Northwest corner of that portion of land set apart for Cornelius Haffey out of said estate; thence South to the Southeast corner of that tract or portion of land set apart for Bernard Haffey; thence South to the place of beginning, containing One Hundred and Eighteen (118) acres, and being a part or portion of the Donation Land Claim of John W. Stevenson and Sarah Stevenson, his wife, situated in Section Four (4), in Township One (1) North, of Range Five (5) East, of Willamette Meridian, in said Skamania County, Washington, the property mortgaged together with the debt thereby secured, is fully PAID, SATISFIED AND DISCHARGED.
