Now Know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and pursuant to said Acts of Congress has given and granted and by these presents does give and grant unto the said Northern Pacific Railway Company, successors in interest to the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, its successors and assigns the tracts of land selected as aforesaid and embraced in the foregoing; To have and to hold the said tracts with the appurtenances thereof unto said Northern Pacific Railway Company and to its successors and assigns forever, expressly excepting from this grant all lands mineral in character now known or hereafter discovered to be such. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the Authority of the United States.

Taft, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed Given under my hand at the city of Washington the twenty third day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twelve and of the independence of the United States the one hundred and thirty seventh
