THIS INDENTURE, Made this Sixteenth day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen between William Crispian and Anna Crispian, husband and wife, party of the first part, and John T. Haffey party of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars, lawful money of the United States, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, thereceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL, CONVEY and WARRANT unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, the following described tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 557.04 feet West of the Northeast corner of the West Two-thirds of John W. Stevenson and Sarah Stevenson, his wife D.L.C.
