IN CONSIDERATION of forty-six thousand eight hundred fifty-five and 50/100 (\$46855.50) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the State of Washington does hereby sell and convey unto W.N.Jones his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, all the standing and fallen merchantable timber now owned by the State of Washington, upon the following described school lands, situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington to-wit: All of section thirty-six (36), township three (3) North, range six (6). east of the Willamette Meridian, containing 640 acres, more or less, according to the government survey thereof. All timber, whether standing or fallen, not removed from said land by said grantee, or those claiming under him, within five years from the date hereof, shall revert to and become the property of the State of Washington as fully to all intents and purposes as if this instrument had not been made; and the right of said grantee, or those claiming under him, to cut or remove timber from said lands shall utterly cease at the expiration of said five years from the date hereof; provided, that in all cases when the purchasers are acting in good faith and removing the said timber, the Board of State Land Commissioners may extend the time of removal for a period not to exceed two years, upon payment of not less than one dollar, nor more than two dollars per acre per year, in which event all timber whether standing or fallen, not removed at the expiration of such extension shall revert to and become the property of said State as fully to all intents and purposes as if said extension had not been made.
