

The second line shall be constructed parallel to and not to exceed 50 feet from and northerly of said survey line. Also the line is surveyed across the said Bishop Donation Land Claim and enters the north line thereof about 997 feet west of the northeast corner of said claim and runs thence southwesterly to a point in the west<sup>line</sup> of said claim 60 feet south of the northeast corner of the G.W. Johnson Donation Land Claim.

The second line shall be constructed parallel with and not to exceed 50 feet from and north of the said survey line.

This instrument is made to take the place of one executed by the grantor to the grantee in the same words and figures about September 29, 1912, which deed is lost.
