O'BRIEN ET AL TO NORTHWESTERN ELECTRIC CO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that, J. P. O'BRIEN, and ANNIE L. O'BRIEN, his wife and R. BLAISDELL, and LILIAN L. BLAISDELL, his wife, of the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon, hereinafter called the GRANTORS, for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty Five and No/100 (\$65.00) Dollars, to them paid by the NORTHWESTERN ELECTRIC COMPANY, a corporation, under the laws of the State of Washington, hereinafter called the ELECTRIC COMPANY, do hereby license and permit the Electric Company, its successors or assigns, to construct and perpetually maintain and operate two pole or tower lines for the transmission of electric current, on, over and across the lands of the Grantors, situated in the County of Skamania and the State of Washington, and known and described as Government Lot three (3) of Section thirty five (35), in Township three (3) North, of Range eight (8) East, W.M. and Government Lot four (4) of Section twenty five (25) in Township three (3) North, of Range nine (9) East, W.M. Said pole lines shall be parallel and not more than fifty (50) feet apart from center to center of poles as shown in Red Color on the blue prints hereto attached, which said blue prints are hereby made a part of this instrument.

The course of the more southerly of said pole lines over and across said lots is particularly described as follows;

Beginning at a point in the East line of said Lot three (3) four hundred and fifty (450) feet North of the center line of the Railway of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company, as the same is now located and established; thence North $70^{\circ} 58'$ West, four hundred and twenty (420) feet to a point; thence North $62^{\circ} 12'$ West, two hundred and sixty two (262) feet to a point; thence North $53^{\circ} 02'$ West, one hundred and forty four (144) feet to a point; thence North $47^{\circ} 57'$ West seven hundred and twenty seven (727) feet to a point; in the west line of said Lot three (3), three hundred and sixty (360) feet North of said center line of said Railway, and leaving said Lot three (3) at the last described point; and

Entering said Lot four (4) on its North line and five hundred and fifty (550) feet East of its Northwest corner; thence South $56^{\circ} 40'$ West seven hundred (700) feet to a point in the West line of said Lot four (4) and leaving said Lot at the last described point.

And permission is hereby granted the Electric Company, its Agents and Employees, to enter upon said lands, to construct, place and erect said pole lines and to cut and remove such brush and trees from said lands as may be necessary in constructing, maintaining said lines and protecting the same from damage. The right of entry upon said lands along said lines at all times after the construction thereof for the purpose of maintaining and repairing the same is hereby granted the Electric Company, its successors or assigns and their employees.

As a further consideration for these presents the Electric Company agrees to and with the Grantors:

First: That it will construct and at all times maintain its lines over and across said lines in a substantial manner with first class material; that its poles shall be of such a
