LINDIS TO HAMILTON

THIS INDENTURE, Made this Ninth day of April in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen Between Emma J. Lindis and Theodore Lindis, her husband, the parties of the first part, and Maggie C. Hamilton, the party of the second part:

Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, lawful money of the United States, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, remise, release, and forever Quit-claim unto the said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns all rights, title, interest and estate of said parties in and to all that certain lot, piece, or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:
