Udell To Haffey

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 29th day of April in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred Thirteen, Between C.W. Udell and Grace Udell husband and wife, the parties of the first part, and Barney Haffey the party of the second part:

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar lawful money of the United States, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, remise, release, and forever quit-claim unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns all right, title, interest and estate of said parties in and to all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:
