

Thence, first course, south seventy-four degrees Twenty-five Minutes west Three hundred feet to a point from which Discovery bears South fifteen Degrees Thirty-five Minutes East Nine Hundred Nine feet Distant; Six Hundred Feet to corner No.2, a larch post three feet high, four inches square, marked 2 - 801;

Thence, Second course; south fifteen degrees thirty-five minutes East One thousand five hundred feet to corner No.3, identical with corner No.4, of said Kangaroo No.2 Lode Claim;

Thence, Third course, North Seventy-four Degrees Twenty-five Minutes East six hundred feet to corner No.4, identical with corner No.3 of said Kangaroo No.2 Lode claim;

Thence, Fourth course, North Fifteen Degrees Thirty-five minutes west one thousand five Hundred feet to corner No.1, the place of beginning; The survey of the Lode claim, as above described, extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Kangaroo No.3 vein or lode;

Beginning, for the description of the Kangaroo No.5 Lode Claim, at corner No.1, a larch post, three feet high, four inches square, marked 1 -801 and 1 801; identical with corner No.1 of said Kangaroo No.4 Lode Claim, from which the corner to Sections Five, Six, Seven, and Eight in Township Nine North of Range six East of the Willamette Meridian, bears North Fifty-three Degrees Fifty-two minutes west one thousand one hundred seventy-six and nine-tenths feet distant;

Thence, First course, South Fifteen Degrees Thirty-five Minutes East one thousand Five Hundred feet to corner No.2, a Larch Post Three Feet high, Four inches square, marked 2 - 801:

Thence, second course, North Seventy-four Degrees Twenty-five minutes East six hundred feet to corner No.3, a Larch Post, three feet high, four inches square, marked 3 - 801;

Thence Third course, North Fifteen degrees thirty-five minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No.4, a Larch Post, Three feet high, four inches square, marked 4 - 801 and 2 - 801; identical with corner No.2 of said Kangaroo No.4 Lode claim;

Thence, Fourth Course, South seventy-four degrees Twenty-five minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which discovery bears south five degrees east fifteen feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No.1, the place of beginning; the survey of the Lode claim, as above described, extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Kangaroo No. 5 Vein or Lode; The Premises, herein granted, containing eighty-two and six hundred forty-four-thousandths acres, more or less.

Now know ye, That there is therefore, pursuant to the law aforesaid, hereby granted by the United States unto the said grantee and to the heirs, or successors, and assigns of said grantee, the said mining premises herebefore described, and not expressly excepted from these presents, and all that portion of the said veins, lodes, or ledges and of all other veins, lodes, and ledges, throughout their entire depth, the tops or apexes of which lie inside of the surface boundary lines of said granted premises in said survey extended downward vertically, although such veins, lodes, or ledges in their downward course may so far depart from a perpendicular as to extend outside the vertical side lines of said premises; Provided, That the right of possession to such outside parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges shall be confined to such portions thereof as lie between vertical planes drawn downward through the end lines of said survey so continued in their own direction that such planes will intersect such exterior parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges; And provided further, That nothing herein contained shall authorize the grantee herein to enter upon the surface of a claim owned or possessed by another.

To Have and to Hold said mining premises, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said grantee above named and to the heirs, or successors, and assigns of said grantee forever; subject, nevertheless, to the above-mentioned and to the following conditions and stipulations;
