Starting at a point on the Columbia River in section eleven (11) Township two (2) North of Range seven (7) East of Willamette Meridian being the northeast corner of the Daniel F. Bradford Donation Land claim where the same intersects the shore line of the Columbia River, running thence north fifty four and one half (54½) degrees west fifty (50) chains, thence south twenty-nine degrees west fifty five (55) chains to the angle corner between the Daniel F.
