

three (23) degrees west forty two and 50/100 (42.50) chains to the angle corner of the place of beginning, containing three hundred and 88/100 acres in section ten (10) eleven (11) fourteen (14) and fifteen (15) being the Isaac H. Bush donation land claim; excepting however that portion which has been logged off around and near the house, the said house being near the angle corner mentioned in the above description at the place of beginning, together with the right to enter upon the land to cut manufacture and remove therefrom at any time within ten years from June 22nd 1907, the timber herein conveyed, hereby granting the right to cut said timber and make such alterations on said land as may be required in the cutting manufacturing and removing of said timber, together with the right to build and operate a skid road or flume upon and across the land reserved and near the house;

Also Lots four (4) five (5) six (6) and nine (9) in section ten (10) Township two (2) north Range seven (7) East of Willamette Meridian, containing ninety one and 95/100 (91.95) acres, together with the right to enter upon said land and cut manufacture and remove therefrom at any time within fifteen years from the 22nd day of June A.D. 1907, the timber herein conveyed, hereby granting the right to cut said timber and make such alterations on said land as may be required in cutting manufacturing and moving said timber;

Also Lots six (6) in Section fourteen (14) and lots two (2) and seven (7) in section fifteen (15) Township two (2) North Range seven (7) East of Willamette Meridian, containing thirty three and 87/100 (33.87) acres, together with the right to enter upon said lands and cut and remove therefrom at any time within ten years from the 22nd day of July 1907 the timber herein conveyed, hereby granting the right to cut such timber and make such alterations on said land as may be required in the cutting and removal of said timber.

To have and to hold the same to the said J.O. Elrod his heirs and assigns for and during the term aforesaid with the exclusive right of occupancy hereby intending to sell and convey to said J.O. Elrod all property and privileges conveyed to Grant Thomas under and by virtue of two certain instruments executed on the 26th day of March 1909 by W.C. Slattery and Delia Slattery his wife and the other by Cascade Tie Company a corporation.

And the said J.O. Elrod do hereby agree to pay all taxes hereafter levied against said lands and that may become payable prior to the cutting of said timber, prior to the day appointed by law for sale of lands from town, county or state taxes.
