This Indenture Witnesseth that G C. Blakely and Bell Blakely husband and wife, parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other lawful considerations to them in hand paid by F.H. Graves, party of the second part have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns the following described premises situate lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

Beginning at a point four hundred thirty (430) feet east and thirty (30) feet south of the northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of section twenty eight (28) in township three (3) North of Range eight (8) East of Willmette Meridian, running thence south one hundred thirty (130) feet, thence west one hundred (100) feet, thence south one hundred thirty four (134) feet, thence east one hundred sixty five (165) feet, thence north two hundred sixty four (264) feet, thence west sixty five (65) feet to point of beginning,

With all and singulat the heredita ents and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining the reservations, remainders, rents issues and profits thereof. To have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging.
