

Two hundred one and three tenths (201.3) feet to the place of beginning excepting a strip of land Sixteen(16) feet wide running East and West through the center of said tract which is hereby reserved for an alley.

This deed being given to correct error in deed given second party by said George Udell on November 21st, 1906 and to supplement same and to transfer additional land, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all our estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD The above described and granted premises unto the said Carrie Jackson her heirs and assigns forever. And we George Udell and Jennie A. Udell, his wife grantors above named do covenant to and with Carrie Jackson the above named grantee her heirs and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances, and that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
