Marsh be and is hereby appointed as sole Executrix of said will and of said estate and in pursuance thereof she is hereby authorized and permitted to so act without filing or giving any bond or undertaking and that upon her taking and filing herein her oath of office the Clerk of this Court be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue Letters testamentary to said Mary E. Marsh and that J.C. Hostetler, H.B. Horrell and J.P. Agidius be and they are hereby appointed Appraisers of said estate.

To the above entitled Court:

Mary E. Marsh, the Executrix of the last will and testament of said deceased, most respectfully represents and shows:

That so far as petitioner has been able to ascertain, the indebtedness of said estate is about Seventeen Thousand Dollars of which the larger part is bearing interest.

That the appraised value of all the personal property of the estate was and is \$13,552.50 or thereabout, for a detailed description of which the Inventory and Appraisement thereof as heretofore made and filed, is hereby referred to and made a part of this petition.

That by the terms of the said will, Testator bequeathed all of his said personal property to his heirs at law, one half to petitioner, and the other half to his four children therein named, share and share alike.

That said Will further provided that all the justs debts and obligations of Testator should be paid together with the expenses of administration funeral expenses etc., but provided
