Be it remembered, That on this 24 day of October, A.D., 1911, the above entitled matter came on to be heard upon the petition of Mary E. Marsh, the Executrix of the last will and Testament, of said deceased, for an order of sale of the personal property of the said estate, petitioner appearing by C.J. Bright, her Attorney, no other person appearing, and said matter having been presented and submitted, and,

It appearing to the Court that the allegations of the said petitioner are true; that it is necessary and proper to sell said personal property for the purpose of paying and discharging the obligations and expenses of the estate; that it will be for the best interest of all concerned that such sale or sales be made at private sale from time to time and that it may be advisable to extend a term of credit upon a portion of the purchase price of a part or all of said property; and it appearing that under the circumstances of the case the sale or trade of the estate automobile under the terms suggested in the petition is advisable, and will be for the best interest of all concerned,

Now therefore it is considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that petitioner's petition be and the same is hereby granted and that she be and is hereby authorized to sell the personal property of the said estate from time to time at private sale for not less than the appraised value except upon the further order of the Court, and may extend a period of credit for not exceeding one year upon not more than half of the purchase price such deferred payments to be by promissory note of the usual commercial form bearing not less than eight per cent per annum, interest and amply secured; that she is further authorized to complete and carry into effect the proposed sale or trade concerning the automobile, and that from time to time she report to the Court her doings under this order.
