Commencing at the Northwest Corner of the Northeast one quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Eleven (11) Township Three (3) North of Range Nine (9) East of the Willamette Meridian, thence east 213.3 feet, thence South  $39^{\circ}53'$  east 228 feet, thence South  $51^{\circ}00'$  east 400 feet, thence South on division line of the forty to center line of quarter section, thence west 665 feet, thence north on division line to place of beginning, containing 17.3/100 acres, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, with their appurtenances unto the said Anna J. Beedle her heirs and assigns forever.
