KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the undersigned SPOKANE, PORTLAND AND SEATTEE RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Railway Company"), in consideration of the covenants and agreements to be kept and performed by the COUNTY OF SKAMANIA, State of Washington, as hereinafter recited, does hereby grant unto said County of Skamania, State of Washington, license and permission to enter upon, use and occupy for the purposes of a public road the following described real estate situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington:

A strip of land sixty (60) feet in width, being thirty (30) feet in width on each side of the center line of the proposed public highway as now located over and across the abandoned right of way of the Railway Company in the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section 35, township 3 north of range 8 east of the Willamette Meridian, said center line of the county road being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north line of said section 35, said point being 2080 feet more or less east of the northwest corner of section 35; thence south 15° 55' east 104 feet; thence south 34° 23' west 51 feet; thence south 69° 06' west 148 feet; thence south 9° 36' east 200 feet; thence south 29° 39' east 436 feet; thence south 41° 58' east 327 feet; thence south 02° 30' east 241 feet; thence south 58° 20' west 300 feet.
