DAVISON TO SKAMANIA LIGHT & POWER COMPANY,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we A. D. Davison and Nellie E. Davison, his wife, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other valuable considerations, to us in hand paid by Skamania Light and Power Company, a corporation of the State of Washington, party of the second part, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns the right to construct, maintain and operate a pole line for the purpose of conveying thereover electricity for light, heat, power or telephone, on over and across the following real estate in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 245 feet south of the center of section 36, tp. 3 N. R. 7½ E. W. M., thence east 126 ft. thence in a southerly direction S 4 deg. 30 min. W 286 ft. to southwest corner of A. Stogsdill's land, thence easterly along the south line of said A. Stogsdill's land 186 ft. more or less to a point as established 396 ft. east of a line extending from north to south through the center of said section 36, thence south 903 ft. more or less, to north line of right of way of S. P. & S. Ry.; thence in a westerly direction along the north side of said right of way 396 feet more or less, to the said center line of said section 36; thence north along the said center line 120.6 feet more or less to a point, on established corner, about 1320 feet south of the center of said section 36; thence west 167 feet more or less, to east line of James Peterson's place, the same being the east line of the Henry Shepard D. L. C., thence north along said east line of said James Peterson's place 640.4 ft. more or less, to N. E. corner of Henry Shepard D. L. C., thence east about 167 feet to aforesaid center line of said section 36, thence north 430.8 feet to place of beginning.

To Have and To Hold unto the said party of the second part and to its successors and assigns for a period of fifty years from the date hereof.

And the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, shall and may have the right to enter upon the said land for the purpose of repairing or examining the said power line, and to do all things reasonably necessary in the operation and maintenance of said line.

It is understood and agreed that the said line shall be maintained at the place where now constructed.
