Wallace of the same place the party of the second part Witnesseth: that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar lawful money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold remises released and forever quitclaimed and by these presents does remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns all those certain lots pieces or parcels of land situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

Lot 5 in Block 2 of the townsite of Coos in Skamania County Washington as per plat filed in the office of the county Auditor of said County and State. Together with all and singular the tenements heretofore and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof. To have and to hold all and singular the the said premise together with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever.
