Range nine East of Wilamette Meridian in Washington, containing one hund ed and forty two acres and twenty five hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said land returned to the general Land Office by the Surveyor general.

Now Know Ye That the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in a coordance with the provisions of the said act of congress of July 4th 1884, hereby declares that it does and will hold the land have described for the period of twenty five years in trust for the sole use and benefit of said Joe Thomas or in case of his death of his widow and heirs according to the laws of the State where such land is located and at the expiration of said period the United States Will convey the same by Patent to the said Joe Thomas or his widow or heirs as aforesaid in fee, discharged of said trust and free of all charge or incumbrance whatsoever, and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by authority of the United States.

In Testimony Whereof I, Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the general Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the city of Washington the eighteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two and of the independence of the United States the one hundred and sixteenth.
