

Range nine East of Wilamette meridian in Washington, containing one hundred and forty two acres and twenty five hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now Know Ye That the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in accordance with the provisions of the said act of congress of July 4th 1884, hereby declares that it does and will hold the land above described for the period of twenty five years in trust for the sole use and benefit of said Joe Thomas or in case of his death of his widow and heirs according to the laws of the state where such land is located and at the expiration of said period the United States Will convey the same by Patent to the said Joe Thomas or his widow or heirs as aforesaid in fee, discharged of said trust and free of all charge or incumbrance whatsoever, and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by authority of the United States.

In Testimony Whereof I, Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the city of Washington the eighteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two and of the independence of the United States the one hundred and sixteenth.

Olin to N.W. Electric Co.

In Consideration of One dollar the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Charles Olin and Hilda Olin his wife grant to Northwestern Electric Company a perpetual right of way in and over the following described property situated in the county of Skamania State of Washington to-wit: Beginning at a point 622 feet south and 60 feet west of the Northeast corner of Lot 9 in Sec. 1 Tp. 2 North of Range 7 East of W.M. ~~XXXXXX~~, thence south 256.2 feet, thence west 100 feet, thence north 256.2 feet, thence east 100 feet to place of beginning, being the land described in deeds recorded in Book 'N' page 60 and page 121 records of said County, for the purpose of erecting maintaining and operating thereon one pole or tower lines for the transmission of electric current, together with the privilege of cutting such trees and brush as may be necessary in constructing maintaining and protecting such lines from damage. The line is surveyed and enters said land about 100 feet south of the Northeast corner running thence in a straight line to a point in the south line about 20 feet east of the southwest corner of said land and in the plan of construction of said transmission line no pole or tower is to stand on the land of the grantor.
