KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that the Clark & Wilson Lumber Company, and Oregon corporation, and the Chee Lumber Company a Washington corporation, in consideration of one dollar to them paid by Skamania County, State of Washington receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby bargain, sell and convey unto the said Skamania County, a right of way for a public county road, over, through and upon the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 23, township 3 North range 9 east, W.M. same being 15 feet in width on each side of the center line of the said public county road known as the Chenoweth Hill road, as the same is now surveyed located and staked out over said tract of land and being particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point where said surveyed line of road crosses the east line of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of said section 23; running thence south 42° 40' west 86.2 ft.; thence south 72° 59' west 83.3 ft.; thence south 89° 24' west 77.6 ft.; thence south 83° 19' west 111.5 ft.; thence north 89° 40' west 133.4 ft.; thence north 83° 06' west 278.5 ft.; and ending at station 95x14.4 of said survey; all situate in Skamania County, State of Washington.

To have and to hold the said to the said Skamania County forever or so long as used for public county road purposes.
