

JOHN T. HAFLEY TO BANK OF STEVENSON

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT JOHN T. HAFLEY THE PARTY OF THE FIRST PART, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE SUM OF ONE DOLLARS, LAWFUL MONEY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, TO HIM IN HAND PAID BY BANK OF STEVENSON, A WASHINGTON CORPORATION THE PARTY OF THE SECOND PART, THE RECEIPT WHEREOF IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED, DOES BY THESE PRESENTS GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL, ASSIGN, TRANSFER AND SET OVER UNTO THE SAID PARTY OF THE SECOND PART, A CERTAIN INDENTURE OF MORTGAGE BEARING DATE THE 16TH DAY OF AUGUST, A.D. 1919, MADE AND EXECUTED BY WILLIAM CRISPIEN AND ANNA CRISPIEN, HIS WIFE TO JOHN T. HAFLEY TO SECURE THE PAYMENT OF TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 DOLLARS, WITH INTEREST THEREON AT SIX PER CENT PER ANNUM FROM AUG. 16, 1919 UNTIL PAID, AND RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF THE COUNTY OF SKAMANIA STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN BOOK O OF MORTGAGES, PAGE 197 ON THE 26TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, A.D. 1919 TOGETHER WITH THE PROMISSORY NOTE THEREIN DESCRIBED, AND THE MONEY DUE AND TO BECOME DUE THEREON, WITH INTEREST.

AND THE SAID PARTY OF THE FIRST PART DOES HEREBY MAKE, CONSTITUTE AND APPOINT THE SAID PARTY OF THE SECOND PART HIS TRUE AND LAWFUL ATTORNEY, IRREVOCABLE IN HIS NAME OR OTHERWISE, BUT AT THE PROPER COSTS AND CHARGES OF THE SAID PARTY OF THE SECOND PART, TO HAVE, USE AND TAKE ALL LAWFUL WAYS AND MEANS FOR THE RECOVERY OF THE SAID MONEY AND INTEREST; AND IN CASE OF PAYMENT, TO DISCHARGE THE SAME AS FULLY AS THE SAID PARTY OF THE FIRST PART MIGHT OR COULD DO IF THESE PRESENTS WERE NOT MADE.
