

Discovery Lode and Norway Discovery Lode, the Northway Northwest Discovery Lode mining claims, designated by the Surveyor General as Lot No. 620 situate in St. Helens Mining District said County and State aforesaid consisting of 44.999 acres more or less according to the official survey thereof, said several mining claims constituting one contiguous parcel of land, the particular description of which is set forth in the patent thereof recorded in Vol. 370 at pages 96 to 100 of the records of Mineral Patents at Washington D.C. and in Book I of Deeds pages 71 to 76 of the records of Skamania County Washington Reference to which patents and their records thereof is hereby made for a more detailed and particular description thereof.

Parcel No. 7 All right title interest and equity of, in and to all other mining locations claims and rights not hereinbefore particularly mentioned consisting of a large number of mining claims duly recorded staked situate in said Spirit Lake Mining District said County and State aforesaid either located by or in the names of the first parties hereto or in which the whole or some interest therein have been conveyed by the locators of the first parties herein or either of them, the particular names and description and the particular book and page of the location of the same not being at hand, but the intention being to convey by this deed generally and particularly every right title and interest of the first parties herein to the second party to all the mining claims and mining rights in said Spirit Lake Mining District, Wheresoever located and recorded and the location certificates together with the deeds or transfers and the records thereof are hereby referred to and made a part of this deed as a more particular description thereof including herein all water rights ditch rights tunnel rights rights of way and incidentals and appurtenant rights held or used in connection with the said several parcels particularly mentioned and the property in equity last referred to, provided however there is reserved and excepted from this conveyance specifically all water rights and appurtenances thereto in, along and upon the Middle Tootle River at and below the outlet of Spirit Lake and also reserving Spirit Lake itself as a reservoir in said district which said last rights are reserved as the private property of the grantors herein. Together with all the dips spurs and angles and also all metals ores gold copper and silver bearing quartz rock and earth therein and all the rights privileges and franchises thereto incident appendant and appurtenant to therewith usually had and enjoyed and also all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the rent issues and profits thereof and also all the estate right title interest property possession claim and demands whatsoever as well in law as in equity of the parties of the first part of in or about the said premises and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances hereby warranting to defend the title of said premises above conveyed against the lawful claims and demands of any person claiming or to claims the same by or through any act or deed of the first parties. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises together with the appurtenances and privileges thereto incident unto the said party of the second part its successors and assigns forever (hereby covenanting that the same is free from any previous transfer claim or lien created by or through the first parties. This deed is given in confirmation and correction of a previous deed of the same property by the same grantors wherein the name of the grantee was erroneously written St. Helens consolidated Mining Company, the intention of that deed having been to convey the property to the grantee herein named and the name having been erroneously written in said deed by clerical error and inadvertance and said deed having been delivered and accepted by this grantee and none other and there being no St. Helens consolidated Mining Company in existence.
