

Greiner et ux to Vancouver Lumber Company.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

THAT Alvia H. Greiner and Orpha Greiner, his wife, the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by Vancouver Lumber Company, a corporation, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the party of the second part a certain Indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 25th day of September, A.D. 1916, made and executed by Ralph Mc. Cauley and Mazie L. McCauley, husband and wife, Mortgagors to Alvia H. Greiner and Orpha Greiner Mortgagees and recorded on the 4th day of October, A. D. 1916, in Book N of Mortgages, at page 311 in the office of the County Auditor of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, mortgaging the following described lands in said county and state, to-wit: The East half (1/2) of the Southeast Quarter (1/4) and the Southeast Quarter (1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (1/4) of Section twenty-two (22), Township Two (2) North, Range Five (5) East, Willamette Meridian.

TOGETHER with the promissory note therein described, and the money due and to become due thereon, with the interest.

AND the said parties of the first part do hereby make, constitute and appoint the said party of the second party true and lawful attorney, irrevocable, in their name or otherwise, but at the proper costs and charges of the said party of the second part, to have, use and take all lawful ways and means for the recovery of the said money and interest, and in case of payment, to discharge the same as fully as the said parties of the first part might or could do if these presents were not made.
