The east half of the north-east quarter and the north-east quarter of the south-east quarter of Section ten (10), in Township three (3) north of Range six (6) east of the Willamette Meridian, containing 120 acres.

To Have and to Hold the said premises, with the appurtenances unto the said M.E. Worrell and his heirs and assigns forever. And we the said Henry Humphrey and Elizabeth Humphrey do hereby covenant to and with the said M.E.
