

Wright to N.W. Electric Co.

In consideration of forty (40) dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Edward R. Wright and Margaret E. Wright husband and wife grant to Northwestern Electric company a perpetual right of way in and over the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington to wit: The Southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section six (6) Township one North of Range five (5) East of Willamette Meridian, for the purpose of erecting maintaining and operating thereon two pole or tower lines for the transmission of electric current and we agree to cut such trees and brush as may be necessary in constructing maintaining and protecting such lines from damage. The lines are to run diagonally across the southwest corner of said tract of land from the turn in the road on the west line of the south line at about one half way along the south line. Any poles erected shall be about midway of the west half of said tract and on the line between the east and west half of the 40 acres. The tree and brush along the south pole line as surveyed shall be cut by us prior to April 1st 1911 and on other when requested. The two pole lines are to be erected not to exceed 50 feet apart. In consideration of one dollar the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged W.F. Bleasing and K.M. Bleasing husband and wife and H.J. Bleasing and K.E. Bleasing husband and wife grant to Northwestern Electric Company a perpetual right of way in and over the following described real property to-wit: The southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section two (2) in Township one (1) North of Range five (5) East of Willamette Meridian, for the purpose of erecting maintaining and operating thereon two pole or tower lines for the transmission of electric current, together with the right to cut such trees and brush as may be necessary for the constructing maintaining and protecting such lines from damage. The south line has been surveyed and staked out across said land and enters the east line about 200 feet north of the southeast corner and runs southwest to a point in the south line about 500 feet west of the southeast corner.
