KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Table Rock Mineral Water Company, a corporation, under the laws of the State of Washington, in consideration of \$1.00 and other valuable considerations to it paid by the Northwestern Electric Company, a corporation, does hereby grant to the Northwestern Electric Company, a perpetual right-of-way in and over the following described real property, situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to wit: The Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 16; also the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 16, and the South One-Half of the Northwest quarter of Section 16 and lots 8 and 9 of Section 16, in Township 2, North, Range 7, East of the Willamette Meridian; and also the East One-Half of the Southeast quarter of Section 17, said Township and Range; also the G.W.
