GODDARD TO UNDERWOOD UNION CHAPEL ASSOCIATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Edmund C. Goddard and Minnie M. Goddard his wife of Portland, State of Oregon, in consideration of One Dollar and other considerations to us paid by Underwood Union Chapel Association of Underwood Washington, have bargained and sold and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto said Underwood Union Chapel Association its heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Skamania Washington, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point South 11' 30" East 20ft distant and North 89° 48' 30" East 20ft distant from the North West Corner of the South West ¼ of the North East ¼ of Section 22. T. 3. N. R. 10 E. W. M. said corner being marked by an iron pipe 1 inch in diameter and 18 inches long driven 1 foot in the ground, thence South 11' 30" East 100 ft to South west Corner of U. V. C. A. ns Tract, Thence north 89° 48' 30" East 100 ft. to South East Corner of Tract, thence North 11' 30" West 100 feet to North East Corner of Tract, Thence South 89° 48' 30" West 100 ft. to North West Corner or the point of beginning, said tract containing 10,000 Sq. feet or .2295 Acres. Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.
