

J.K. LUMBER COMPANY TO STATE OF WASHINGTON.

IN THE MATTER OF State Road No.8, otherwise known as the Columbia River Road.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J.K.Lumber Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington, with its principal place of business at Stevenson, Washington, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollar paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the State of Washington the following described parcel of land situated in Skamania County, in the State of Washington, to-wit:

A strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of line of said Road as surveyed over and across the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 2, and the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 11 in the F.G? Iman D.L.C. No.44, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of W.M. excepting all rights now acquired by the Northwestern Electric Company and excepting and reserving unto the said J.K.Lumber Company, its successors and assigns, all timber now standing upon said right of way, with full liberty of ingress, egress and regress at all times, for it, the said J.K.Lumber Company, its successors and assigns and its and their servants, agents and workmen in and upon the said right of way, with horses, wagons and any implements, tools and equipment that may be necessary for the purpose of removing the timber from said right of way.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the State of Washington for the purpose of a public road forever.
