# KRIBS TO BURGHARDT.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Frederick A. Kribs and Anna M. Kribs, husband and wife, of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations to us in hand paid by E.H.H. Burghardt, of Stevenson, County of Skamania, State of Washington, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and convey unto said E.H.H. Burghardt, his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington: All that piece or parcel of land known as Rock Creek Island situate in and being a part of the Daniel Baughman Donation Land Claim in Section One (1) of Township Two (2) North of Range Seven (7) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing fifteen acres more or less.

Also all that part of the Easterly one half of the Daniel Baughman Donation Land Claim in Section One (1) Township Two (2) North of Range Seven (7) East of the Willamette Meridian lying west of and adjoining said Rock Creek Island and south of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway right of way as now located, containing 20.67 acres more or less, excepting from the tract of land hereinabove first described the right of way conveyed to the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company, and upon which their railroad track is now located
