JAMISON TO ERIKSON.

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That O.P.^m Jamison and F.N. Jamison, his wife of Portland, of County of Multnomah, State of Oregon in consideration of One Hundred and of other valuable considerations to them paid by John B. Erikson, County of Clark, State of Oregon, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and convey unto said John B. Erikson, his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Skamania, and State of Washington. An undivided half interest in and to the following lands to-wit: South half (S1/2) of North half (N 1/2) North west quarter (NW1/4) of South west quarter (SW 1/4); East half (E1/2) of South East quarter (SE1/4), and North west quarter (NW1/4) of South East quarter (SE1/4) of Section Four (4); The East half (E1/2) of Section Seventeen (17) in Township Two (2) North Range Five (5) East of the W.M. And an undivided half of all the merchantable timber now being or growing on the NW1/4 of NE1/4; NW1/4 of SE1/4 and NE1/4 of NW1/4 of Section 20 in Township 2 N.R. 5 E.W.M. together with all the logging rights mentioned in that certain deed of Erikson to Jamison which is to conduct logging operations thereon including building dams, railroad shutes building and any devise necessary for proper logging operations for 50 years from Jan. 8, 1906 Also and undivided half interest in SW1/4 of Sec. 3 Tp.2N, R. 5 E.W.M. together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all their estate right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.

Erikson the above named grantee his heirs and assigns, that he will, and his heirs, executors and administrators, shall warrant and defend the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof, against the acts and deeds of said grantor, and all persons claiming by, from through or under the said grantor unto the said grantee his heirs and assigns forever.
