State of Oregon, has bargained and sold, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said James A. Haran and unto his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington:

An undivided four-fifths (4/5) interest in and to all the standing and fallen timber on the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 3, North, Range 10 East W.M.

The sole purpose of the foregoing deed is to correct an error in a former deed from Alice Sheehy to James A. Haran, dated January 8th, 1915, and recorded on Page 195 in book "P" Record of Deeds of Skamania County, Washington.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto, belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all her estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the above described and granted premises unto the said James A. Haran, and to his heirs and assigns forever. Haran, the above named grantee his heirs and assigns that she is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances, and that she will and her heirs, executors and administrators, shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
