The Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-nine (29) in Township Two (2) North of Range Six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian; reserving a right of way for a County Road through the North East quarter of said described land on the most feasible and practical route to connect with the present county road leading to Butler Station,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the said premises, with all their appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever; and the said Herbert H. Bushnell and Minnie M.
