JACKSON TO STATE OF WASHINGTON

IN THE MATTER OF STATE ROAD KNOWN as the State Road # 8 .

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That R.E. Jackson and Laura M. Jackson his wife, the State of of the county of Grant, in Oregon in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollar, paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and convey unto the State of Washington, the following described parcel of land, situated in Skamania County, in the State of Washington. to-wit: A strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the centerline of said road as surveyed over and across Lot one (1) Section 32 Township 3 North of Range 9 East W.M.

The consideration for this right of way is hereby stipulated to be, the construction by the State of Washington, for grantors herein, of a good wagon road connecting on to said State Road #8 by a approach, on the property of grantors herein, at a point to be determined as most advantageous and extending therefrom in a southerly direction to the south side of Right of Way of the Spokane Portland & Seattle R.R. using the present location of grantors private crossing thereof, which crossing will require only some repair, and there terminating.

The use of said road so constructed, being hereby granted to those in charge of work in building said State Road # 8, as a convenience in the taking in of supplies and material used in the construction thereof. But same to be and remain the private property of grantors herein their heirs or assigns.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the State of Washington for the purpose of a public road forever.
