W. M. for more particular description of which reference is hereby made to the inventory of the Estate. That this estate has been fully administered, and that the receipts of the Sheriff and Assessor of Multnomah County are filed and attached to said final account showing that there are no unpaid personal taxes against said estate.

It is therefore hereby ordered and decreed by the Court that said final account is in all respects allowed and settled, that the real property in the State of Washington, and above described is hereby decreed to be vested, and is vested, in and by the terms of the Will of deceased, in Hiram Bennett, as residuary legatee, and that said executor be, and he hereby is discharged from his trust and said estate is hereby closed.
