TO HAVE AND TO HOOD, the above granted premises with all the rights easements and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Clara J. Bowman, her heirs and assigns forever. And the said grantor does covenant to and with the said grantee her heirs and assigns that she is lawfully seized in fee of the above granted premises; that they are free from all incumbrances Except an incumbrance of Two hundred Dollars, for two years at 7% interest, payable semi-annually from May 1st, 1915. and that she will and her heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the above granted premises, to the said grantee their heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons except said incumbrance which the Grantees assume and agree to pay.
